## CRITERIA FOR MAG AWARDS

### **Hardman Cup:**

The Hardman Cup was established by Dr. Lamartine Hardman. This award is presented for the achievement of anyone who, “in the judgment of the Association has solved any outstanding problem in public health or made any discovery in surgery or medicine or such contribution to the science of medicine, including but not limited to excellence in the field of medical education.”

Nominations are made by component county medical societies and all nominations must have supporting data. It is only given when an individual has done outstanding work or made an outstanding contribution to medicine or public health, and is not necessarily given annually.

### **Joseph P. Bailey, M.D. Physician Distinguished Service Award:**

This award is presented for distinguished and meritorious service that reflects credit and honor on the Association. Nominations of this award are made by component county medical societies, which are to supply supporting data. The award in the past has been given annually, but is given only when merited.

### **Physician’s Award for Community Service:**

This award recognized physicians for many and varied services above and beyond the call of duty that they render to their respective communities. Wyeth-Ayerst makes the award available.

### **The Jack A. Raines Humanitarian Award:**

Formerly presented as the Civic Endeavor Award, the Jack A. Raines Humanitarian Award is given in recognition of that physician who has made an outstanding humanitarian contribution to his or her fellow man, community, country or world community beyond the normal practice of medicine.

### **Donna Glass Non-Physician Distinguished Service Award:**

This award honors a non-physician in Georgia who has distinguished herself or himself in regards to contributions made to the advancement and support of medicine. The award will be presented at the Annual Meeting only when merited. Nominations of this award are made by individual physicians or component county medical societies, which are to supply supporting data.

### **John B. Rabun Award:**

This award was established in 1993. Its criteria allows it to be presented to more than one recipient in recognition of outstanding community service by county medical societies who perform outstanding community service to make medicine prominent in their communities.

### **The Lamartine Hardman Cup:**

The Lamartine Hardman Cup was established by Dr. Lamartine Hardman. This award is presented for the achievement of anyone who, “in the judgment of the Association has solved any outstanding problem in public health or made any discovery in surgery or medicine or such contribution to the science of medicine, including but not limited to excellence in the field of medical education.”

Nominations are made by component county medical societies and all nominations must have supporting data. It is only given when an individual has done outstanding work or made an outstanding contribution to medicine or public health, and is not necessarily given annually.
