Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §31-33-3, effective July 1 of each year, the costs related to medical record retrieval, certification, and copying may be adjusted in accordance with the medical component of the consumer price index. The Office of Planning and Budget (OPB) is responsible for calculating the annual inflation adjustment and publishing the revised rates. OPB has reviewed the rates and has elected to maintain rates at the current level.
