As a reminder of the democratic operation of your state medical association, we want to take this opportunity to notify every MAG member that your input shapes the policy and work of MAG. This work is addressed by the House of Delegates, the Association's policy-making body.

This year's meeting will be held October 4 and 5, 2008 at the Intercontinental Buckhead in Atlanta.

If your society wishes to introduce an item of business at this year's House meeting, you may submit resolutions by support of either your society's delegate or any delegate agreeing to present your item of business.

All resolutions received on or before August 21, 2008 will be placed in the Delegates' Handbook. Any resolution coming in after that date and before October 4 will be considered late resolutions, and must be forwarded to the Annual Sessions Committee for its approval. Please note: If your subject is regarding the Constitution and Bylaws, it must be sent to MAG by August 21, 2008 in order to meet the 45 days deadline set by our current Constitution and Bylaws. Handbooks will be mailed out to all delegates on September 15, 2008.

We want to urge participation in this House of Delegates by all MAG members. **Please forward any resolutions your society's delegation wishes to present to MAG to Donald Palmisano, MAG General Counsel by August 21, 2008.** In order to provide the best service and increase efficiency, **each solution must be submitted to the General Counsel in word format via e-mail to dpalmisano@mag.org.** **The receipt of all resolutions received is confirmed by a return e-mail.** If you do not receive such an e-mail, your resolution has not been received.
