

MAG recruiting *Doctor of the Day* volunteers for 2009 legislative session

MAG's Department of Government Relations is gearing up for the 2009 legislative session, and it's recruiting volunteers to serve as the *Doctor of the Day* at the Medical Aid Station at the State Capitol. *Doctor of the Day* volunteers provide free minor medical care to legislators and their staff for one or more days during the legislative session, which begins on January 12 and usually ends in mid-April.
