13 Whereas, the Association of Physicians of Pakistani Descent membership includes over 200 physicians  
14 across the state of Georgia; and

16 Whereas, part of MAG’s mission is to facilitate representation of all physicians and their patients in our  
17 fair state; now therefore be it
